About Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024)

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. Audi stopped making the 50 quattro in 2024 and replaced it with the Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 55 quattro (2023-...). You can still find Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) on the used car market, with prices starting around \$43,375.

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 244 mi on a single charge — ranked №389 out of 820 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) is equipped with a powertrain that delivers up to 220 kW (295 hp) of power and 339 lb-ft of torque.

This enables a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 5.8 seconds (№41 out of 116 ranked positions, among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and a top speed of 112 mph.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

The estimated real-world range for Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) is 244 miles, ranking it №123 out of 249 ranked positions. Several conditions can influence this range:

- Speed: The battery drains faster at higher speeds.
- Temperature: Extreme temperatures can impact range.
- Terrain: Range is reduced on hilly or mountainous terrain.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving behaviors, such as frequent acceleration and braking, decrease efficiency.
- Feature utilization: Climate control and media system usage also affect range.

These figures are approximations, and your actual driving range may vary. When planning trips, consider these factors and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) in the USA is equipped with a CCS Type 1 charging port. You can charge it conveniently at home using a standard outlet, or utilize any public AC charging station with the appropriate cable. However, the car's built-in charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging speed to 11 kW, which translates to roughly 32 miles of range added per hour.

For faster charging, use DC fast-charging stations. The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024)

supports a maximum DC charging rate of 175 kW, but it's important to note that battery temperature and current charge level can affect the actual charging speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) comes in the following dimensions:

- Length: 180.6 in
- Width: 83 in (including side mirrors) or 73.4 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 63.5 in
- Wheelbase: 108.8 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 4718 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Behind the rear seats of the Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024), you'll find 18.9 cubic feet of storage space ([Nº72 out of 157 ranked positions](#), among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding down the rear seats expands the total cargo capacity to 51.6 cubic feet ([Nº91 out of 177 ranked positions](#), among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (2021-2024) can safely tow up to 2646 lbs, provided that the trailer has its own braking system.
