About Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022)

The Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) is an all-electric SUV. It came out in 2020. Audi stopped making the 55 quattro in 2022 and replaced it with the Audi Q8 Sportback e-tron 55 quattro (2022-...). You can still find Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) on the used car market, with prices starting around €30,888.

The Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) has a 95 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 351 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 24.6 kWh per 100 km (or 4.06 km per kWh) — ranked №594 out of 933 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 5.5 seconds (№39 out of 118 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 124 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 300 kW (402 hp) of power and 490 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) is 218 miles (№154 out of 262 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) has a CCS Type 1 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, which translates to approximately 25 miles of range added per

hour of charging.

- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 155 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Here are the dimensions and weight for the Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022):

- Length: 193 in
- Width: 86.2 in (including side mirrors) or 76.2 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 63.6 in
- Wheelbase: 115.3 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 5754 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Here's a breakdown of the Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) cargo space:

- Trunk capacity: With the rear seats up, you get 21.7 cubic feet of cargo space in the back ([Nº52 out of 161 ranked positions](#), among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Max cargo capacity: Fold down the rear seats, and you open up 58.4 cubic feet of total cargo space ([Nº71 out of 193 ranked positions](#), among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Frunk capacity: The front trunk is called a "frunk", and it offers an additional 2.1 cubic feet for storing small items.

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Audi e-tron Sportback 55 quattro (2020-2022) has a towing capacity (braked) of up to 4000 lbs (maximum weight the car can tow safely with a trailer that has its own brakes).
