About Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024)

The Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024) is an all-electric sedan. It came out in 2023. Citroën stopped making the 54 kWh in 2024 and replaced it with the Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2024-...). You can still find Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024) on the used car market, with prices starting around €25,215.

The Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024) has a 54 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 355 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 14.3 kWh per 100 km (or 6.99 km per kWh) — ranked №579 out of 933 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 8.9 seconds (№73 out of 118 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 93 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 115 kW (154 hp) of power and 192 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024) is 221 miles (№151 out of 262 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024) has a CCS Type 2 charge port.

 You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, which translates to approximately 43 miles of range added per hour of charging. • For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 101 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Here are the dimensions and weight for the Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024):

• Length: 181.1 in

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Here's a breakdown of the Citroën e-C4 X 54 kWh (2023-2024) cargo space:

- Trunk capacity: With the rear seats up, you get 18 cubic feet of cargo space in the back (№78 out of 161 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
